# Professional Writing Tutoring

- Professional writing tutors have graduate degrees in writing-intensive disciplines
- Receive expert help with any assignment, at any stage of the writing process, from brainstorming to outlining to editing
- 30 or 60 minute one-on-one appointments
  - You must make an appointment ahead of time unless attending a drop-in workshop
- Tutors can help you bounce ideas off someone with writing expertise, learn new writing strategies, and see your writing from a new perspective

- ▶ Students motivating themselves to avoid procrastination

- Class too hard or easy

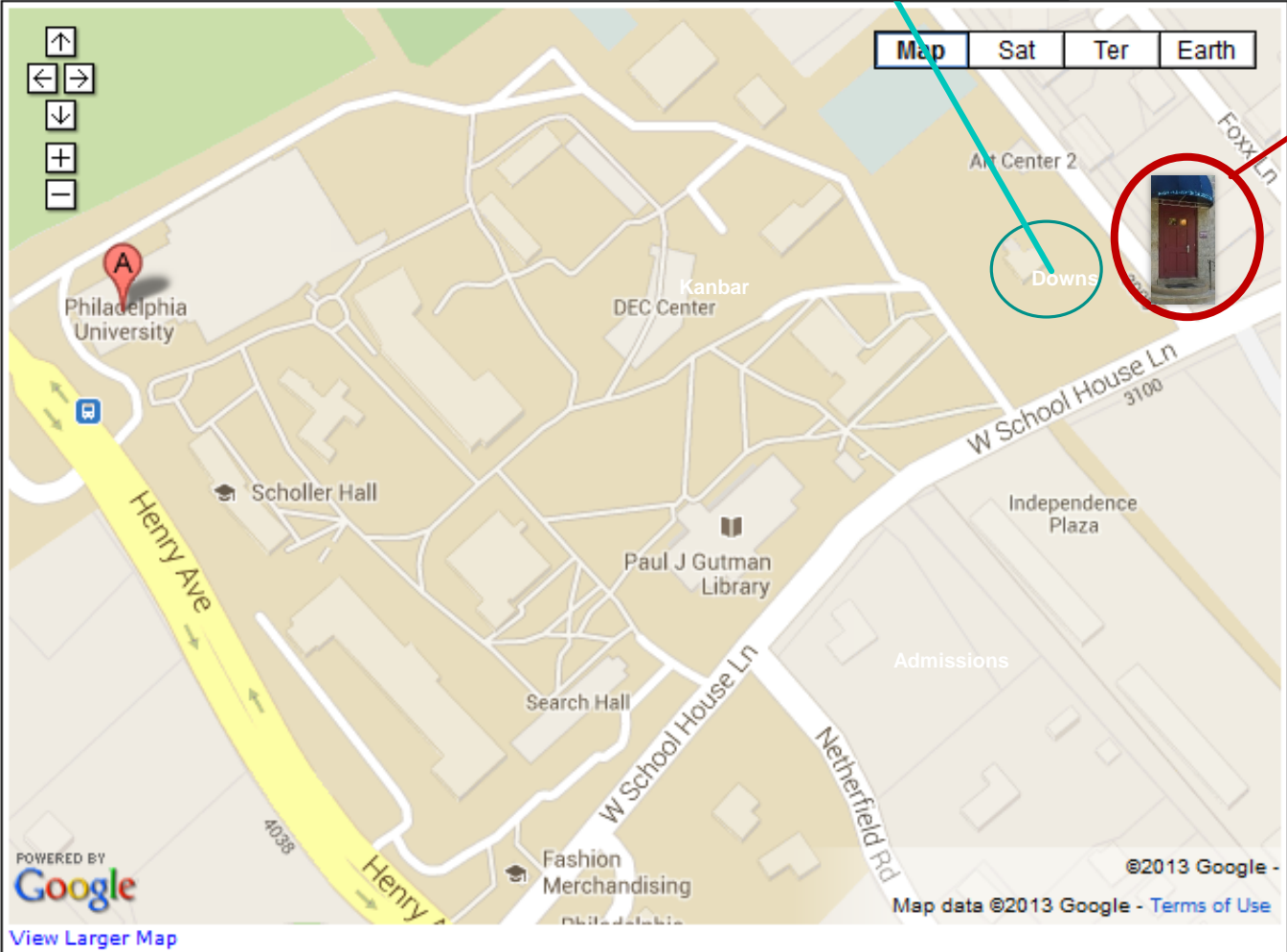
