### Notes: Maintaining Your Honors Status

- † 4 Honors general education courses + 4 Honors courses in the major (Transfer honors credits accepted)
- † Honors students must maintain a 3.25 Cumulative GPA
- † In order to earn Honors credit for a course, Students must earn at least a C+ in the course.
- † All Honors coursework appears on the transcript.
- † 80 hours of required co-curricular activity (4 Cornerstones x 20 hours of engagement per Cornerstone = 80 hours)
- † ALL HONORS COURSEWORK MUST BE COMPLETED DURING THE UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM
